Data Trusts

Key child care stakeholders can work collaboratively to develop a **Data Trust Agreement (DTA)** to guide the sharing and use of critical child care data for essential workers



- A stakeholder webinar can be given to detail the temporary data governance process, materials, and guidance Stakeholders will use a DTA template to detail temporary data and technical needs, roles and responsibilities, and approved users and uses of the combined data
- Stakeholders will have a “how to” guide to develop and execute their temporary DTA
- BrightHive will work with stakeholders to capture critical information to bring DTA “up to code” once emergency phase subsides

3x5 and Google Sheet Systems

Days and Hours of Operation

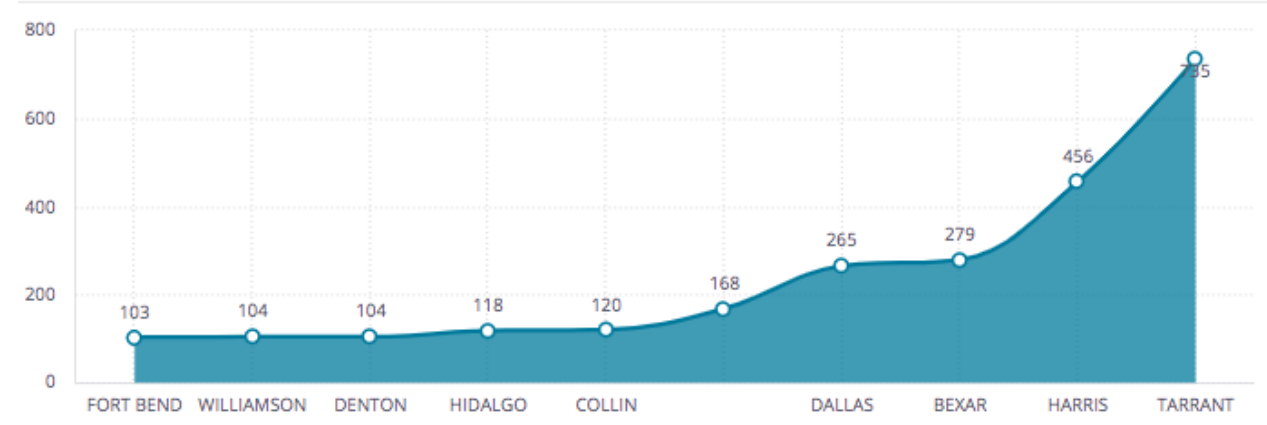

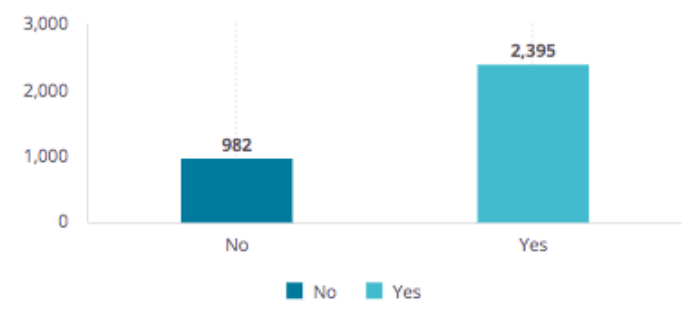
Reporting Status



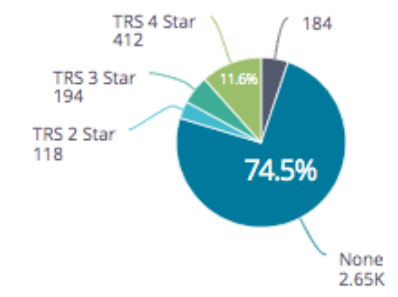
