# Data Trusts



Key child care stakeholders can work collaboratively to develop a **Data Trust Agreement (DTA)** to guide the sharing and use of critical child care data for essential workers



- A stakeholder webinar can be given to detail the temporary data governance process, materials, and guidance Stakeholders will use a DTA template to detail temporary data and technical needs, roles and responsibilities, and approved users and uses of the combined data
- Stakeholders will have a "how to" guide to develop and execute their temporary DTA
- BrightHive will work with stakeholders to capture critical information to bring DTA "up to code" once emergency phase subsides
